

DAVIESS COUNTY -H FEEDER CALF PROJECT




College of Agriculture, Food and Environment Cooperative Extension Service

Minimum age for participation is 9 years old *(as of January 1, 2023)*

Registration will begin in January 2023

The project starts on the 1st Saturday of Spring Break with calf pick-up

- Short-term beef project.
- Calves are purchased from a pool of feeder calves or participants may use their own calves if they meet the age requirements.
- Participants must attend scheduled meetings and weigh-ins.
- Calves are shown in a special class at the Daviess County Lions Club Fair in July.
- Calves qualify for and are sold at the August CPH Sale.



Estimated Timeline: Five months.

Estimated Cost: \$1,100-plus.

Estimated Space Requirement: 200 sq. ft. shelter plus 500+ sq. ft. pen/grazing area.

Estimated Youth Outcome: Goal setting, record keeping, critical thinking, decision making, communication, responsibility, marketable skills, self-discipline, leadership.
