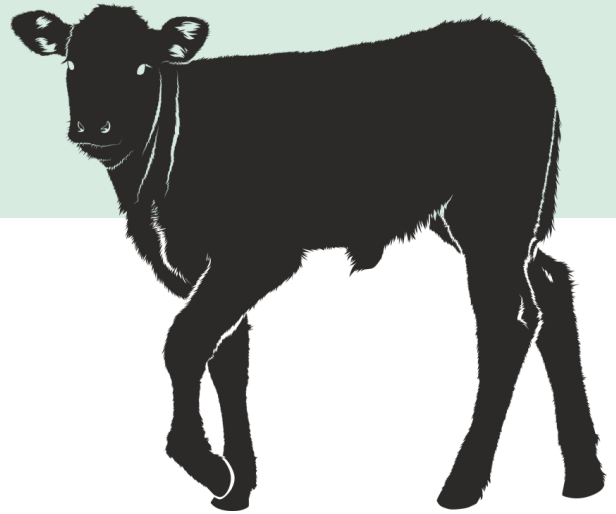

- Short-term beef project.
- Calves are purchased from a pool of feeder calves or participants may use their own calves if they meet the age requirements.
- Participants must attend scheduled meetings and weigh-ins.
- Calves are shown in a special class at the Daviess County Lions Club Fair in July.
- Calves qualify for and are sold at the August CPH Sale.



**Estimated Timeline:** Five months.

**Estimated Cost:** \$1,100-plus.

**Estimated Space Requirement:** 200 sq. ft. shelter plus 500+ sq. ft. pen/grazing area.

**Estimated Youth Outcome:** Goal setting, record keeping, critical thinking, decision making, communication, responsibility, marketable skills, self-discipline, leadership.
