Daviess County 4-H Camp Scholarship Form

Campers may be eligible to receive a partial scholarship towards the camp fee by:

- Completing the scholarship application, including the essay.
- Returning the completed application and all required documentation to the Daviess County Extension Office.
- All campers must pay a camp fee deposit of \$50 and turn it in with their application. If a camper is awarded a scholarship, they will be notified. Any remaining fees will be due by **June 3**.
- Scholarships are awarded on a first come, first serve basis. Return your applications early to ensure funds are still available. Depending on available funds, campers who have received funding in previous years may receive a reduced amount.

Completed scholarship applications must include:

An essay (minimum 150 words) titled "Why I Want to Go to 4-H Camp." The essay should reflect why attending 4-H Camp is important to the youth and what specific lessons, skills, and experience the camper hopes to bring home from his/her stay at Camp.

- The essay should be typed or written very neatly in black or blue ink.
- The title and the camper's name should appear at the top of the essay.
- Proper grammar, structure (introduction, body, conclusion), and spelling will be considered, along with creativity and content of the narrative.
