Breakfast Pizza

Ingredients:

- —Cooking spray
- —2 (8 ounce) tubes reduced-fat crescent rolls
- —⅓ pound breakfast sausage
- —1 cup (4 ounce) fresh mushrooms, chopped or sliced

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Spray a cookie sheet.
- 2. Press crescent rolls onto the cookie sheet with fingers to create one even sheet of dough.
- 3. Pinch up the edges to hold toppings.
- 4. In a skillet, brown sausage and drain.
- 5. Sprinkle sausage, mushrooms, onion, green pepper, and tomatoes evenly over the dough.
- 6. Pour eggs over top and sprinkle with cheese.
- 7. Bake for 20 minutes or until lightly browned.
- **8.** Cut into squares with a pizza cutter and serve.

- —1/2 cup chopped onion
- —1/2 cup green pepper, chopped
- —1/2 cup tomatoes, chopped
- —4 eggs well-beaten
- —1 cup shredded cheddar cheese



Notes: Fat and cholesterol can be reduced by using low-fat cheese and 6 egg whites instead of 4 eggs.
