HELPING HANDS CLUB





Farmers' Market salsa

Ingredients:

- 5 medium tomatoes, chopped
- 1 jalapeño, chopped
- 1 garlic clove, peeled and minced
- ½ medium red onion, peeled and cut into ¼
 -inch pieces
- 1 (75 ounce) can black beans, drained and rinsed
- 3 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon pepper
- 1 tablespoon fresh cilantro, chopped



Servings: 8 Serving Size: 1/2 cup

Directions:

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water.
- 2. In a medium bowl, mix all ingredients.
- 3. Serve or store salsa in refrigerator for up to three days in a covered plastic or glass container.
